



## **Banana Pudding**

Who doesn't love pudding, but can dogs really eat pudding too? Well, kind of. This pudding recipe won't be the sweet treat you are used to. This is a dog-friendly version that your dog will love.

Prep time: 15 minutes

Chill Time: 2 hours

Total time: 2:15 hours

## **INGREDIENTS:**

· 1 large ripe banana

- · 2 egg yolks
- ·1½ tbsp Honest Kitchen Goat's Milk
- ·1 tsp corn starch

## **DIRECTIONS:**

- 1. Mash the banana with a fork until smooth.
- 2. Hydrate the goat's milk powder by stirring in 1/2 cup of warm water and add the mashed banana.
- 3. In a separate bowl, whisk the egg yolks and cornstarch together.
- 4. Stir all ingredients together and pour into a small saucepan.
- 5. Heat on low, stirring constantly until thick. Remove from heat and continue stirring until desired consistency.
- 6. Cover with plastic wrap. Chill in the fridge for 2-3 hours. \*Lay the plastic wrap on the surface of the pudding to prevent a film from forming while the mixture cools.
- 7. Serve by the dollop onto your pet's meals. Store in the fridge for up to 5 days.
