



Cantaloupe Ice Cream

If you have a senior pet that might not have all the teeth that they once did, a great soft-serve ice cream is a fantastic frozen treat. Try it with any fruits, but we chose cantaloupe for it's texture and sweetness.

Prep time: 10 minutes

Freeze time: 4 hours

Total time: 4:10 hours

INGREDIENTS:

· 2 cups of ripe cantaloupe

· ½ cup of plain yogurt

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Cut the melon up into bite-sized cubes, lay them single-layer on a parchment-lined baking sheet, and freeze for several hours, preferably overnight.
- 2. Add the frozen cantaloupe chunks and the yogurt to a food processor and blend until smooth.
- 3. Add water a little at a time until you get a creamy smooth ice cream texture. (too much water will give you a slushy texture, so don't go overboard)
